

DO'S AND **DON'TS**

1. **DO BE ON TIME!** Don't forget, we operate on Central Time.
Remember: If you're early, you're on time...if you're on time, you're late!
2. **DO STAY IN GROUPS!** Never go off alone.
The larger the group, the better.
3. **DON'T EVER LEAVE CAMPUS.** Leaving the campus will constitute sending you home at your expense.
4. **DON'T LEAVE YOUR ROOM AFTER CURFEW.**

5. **DON'T SWITCH ROOMS OR MOVE FURNITURE.** All beds and furniture must stay in the room it belongs in. If you have an issue with your rooming assignment, please talk to your chaperone.
6. **DON'T ALLOW THE OPPOSITE SEX IN YOUR ROOM.**
Plainly stated: no girls in guys' rooms and no guys in girls' rooms.
No exceptions! Chaperones will inspect rooms.
7. **DO ABIDE BY THE LIGHTS-OUT POLICY.** Rest is part of how God refuels your gifts.
8. **DON'T SMOKE, DRINK, OR DO DRUGS AT ANY TIME** or have possession of any of these things. Your parents will be notified, and you will be sent home immediately at your expense.

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12. **DO DRESS APPROPRIATELY.** Watch the length of your shorts and skirts. Do not wear shirts with cut-off sleeves. Do not wear any article of clothing that displays provocative messages. Regular tank tops are OK. Tube tops, crop tops, tanks/t-shirt cutoffs that reveal the chest through sleeve-holes, etc, are not. Shorts for guys and girls both should be at least a 5" inseam, and should not be rolled up. The only cheeks we should see are on your face. Leggings are OK as long as shirts worn over them cover the bottom.
