Arrival and Departure:

- **Check-in: Sunday, June 28 | 12:00 – 3:00 PM CST** in the lobby of the Student Union Building (MTSU Student Union Building, 1768 MTSU Boulevard)
- **Medications:** Please check in all medications at the nurse's station, labeled, and in a sealed gallon-size bag. **GIRLS - Corlew Dorm / GUYS - JCH Dorm**

Please Note: Whether students are flying or driving, everyone begins and ends at the registration tables located in the lobby of the Student Union Building.

That is the first and last stop for every student attending Camp Electric.

If you're driving to campus, **students can leave their luggage in the vehicle** while they complete registration. If a vehicle will remain on campus during the week, it must be parked in the Softball Lot. Be sure to scan the parking QR to register your vehicle with MTSU.

Once students reach the registration tables, they'll line up by last name, either at the guys tables or the girls tables, and receive important camp items before heading to their assigned dorms.

Flying In: Shuttles will run from 9:30 AM – 2:00 PM CST.

Student Pick-Up: Thursday, July 2 | 10:00 – 11:00 AM please gather your luggage and clean your room, then drop off your dorm keycard and room key at the Student Union Building. If someone other than the parent/guardian is picking up, please send written permission on Day 1.

MTSU requires a Participation Form to be completed by every person staying overnight in the residence halls. This form **MUST** be signed by the camper **AND** a parent or guardian.

Instrument Tips:

- Do not bring heirloom instruments

Track-Specific Packing:

- Acoustic/Electric Guitar: Case, strings, picks, tuner, plastic bag
- Bass: Same as above
- Drums: Sticks & practice pad(s) - No Drum Kits
- Media: Camera, laptop/smartphone helpful
- DJ/Producing: Thumb drive, MP3 copies of your tracks, laptop/smartphone helpful
